The Bay of Pigs

- 1. The CIA was secretly training 1,500 Cuban exiles in Central America in order to invade Cuba

The Berlin Crisis

- 1. Khrushchev demanded the US and its allies recognize Communist East Germany as an independent nation and to withdraw from West Berlin
- 2. Kennedy called reserve troops to active duty, launched a program to build shelters in the US against nuclear attack, and began a troop buildup in West Germany
- 3. Khrushchev threatened to mobilize troops
- 4. Kennedy waited for Khrushchev's next move
- **5. Berlin Wall** built in 1961 to block East Germans from escaping to freedom in West Berlin

Washington, Oct. 22 (Special).-President Kennedy declared tonight that the U.S. will turn back all ships carrying offensive weapons to Cuba and regard any nuclear attack launched from Cuba as an assault calling for "a full retaliatory response upon the Soviet Union."

Kennedy told the world that a series of "offensive misile sites," now being built on Cuba constitute "an expressed threat to the peace and security of all the Americas in flagrant and deliberate defiance" of the UN charter and the inter-American defense pact.

As a result of the "reckless and provocative threats to world peace," Kennedy announced seven sweeping actions designed to block the Russian millitary buildup and at the same time seek a peaceful way out of the crisis.

"To halt this offensive buildup," he declared, "A strict quarantine on all offersive military equipment under ship-svent to Cube is being initiated."



Peace Corps- trains and sends volunteers to poor nations to serve as educators, health care workers, agricultural advisers, and in other jobs

Alliance for Progress - provided economic aid to Latin America

Flexible Response- response strategy to nuclear tensions that involved strengthening conventional US forces so the nation would have options other than nuclear weapons in times of crisis

New Frontier- nickname given to President Kennedy's plans for changing the nation

The Warren Court

- 1. Supreme Court decisions were responsible for major changes in American society
- 2. <u>Warren Court</u>- refers to the years when Earl Warren served as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court
- 3. Ruled that legislative districts must have equal populations, guaranteeing that each citizen's vote has equal weight (one person, one vote)
- 4. Established that the search warrants applied to state and local police, states must provide free lawyers to poor persons being tried for crimes, a person has a right to a lawyer during police questioning
- 5. Banned formal prayers in public schools and prohibited daily Bible readings in school

- 1. Kennedy was seeking re-election in 1964
- 2. Went to Dallas to deliver a speech
- 3. Kennedy, Governor John Connally, and their wives rode in an open car of a motorcade through Dallas
- 4. Shots rang out from the sixth floor of a schoolbook depository building
- 5. Police arrested Lee Harvey Oswald as a suspect
- 6. Oswald was killed two days later by Jack Ruby
- 7. <u>Warren Commission</u>- commission headed by Chief Justice Earl Warren to investigate the assassination of President Kennedy


